The Boyen Collection consists of photographs taken by and of Louis E. Boyen at Nome in 1908. There are two photographs of Louis E. Boyen with his partners. The other photographs in the collection are of mining at Center Creek, a gold mine, a gold dredge at midnight, an Eskimo hunting with a skin boat, and an Eskimo on the beach.
