**Administrative/Biographical History:**

Cliff Fuglestad came to Alaska in 1947 to *“live out a dream that he’d had since he was a young boy in Richmond, CA.”* Prior to his life in Alaska, Cliff began working for the Southern Pacific Railroad doing survey work. This survey work took Cliff to Alaska in 1947 after Congress had invested funds for the rehabilitation of the railroad. Cliff recalled his time in Anchorage, and around Alaska stating, *“We lived in a train car, heated by a coal stove. Sometimes it would get so cold you’d put a bucket of water by the stove at night and in the morning it would be frozen.”*

Cliff also had a dream of learning how to fly and buying an airplane. In 1950, his dreams came true and he purchased a Piper, which he credits as *“opening a whole new world”* for him.

Joan Wellenstein Fuglestad grew up in Minnesota and had a spirit for adventure and seeing the country. In 1954 she married Cliff, and together they traveled the state, taking pictures, hunting, fishing, skiing, and flying. Cliff described Joan as a *“a real live wire – and cute.”*

Together they lived their Alaskan dream and raised a family, who has all remained here in Alaska.

**Scope and Content Description:**

The collection consists of 351 35 mm slides depicting various Alaskan scenes from 1948 through 1957 and 1960 through 1971. Several images were taken aerially from the Fuglestad's plane, others were taken from road trips throughout the state. Some images have identified friends and family members, others in the collection are unidentified. For more information, see Detailed Description of Collection.

Notes: Joan Fuglestad, the donor, passed away before the collection was processed. Her son, Eric Fuglestad provided the following biographical note regarding Joan's life:

*"Joan Fuglestad, November 20, 1933-July 18, 2020 – In 1951 her brother, Wally Wellenstein, met her and their folks in Montana from where they drove up the Alcan together while Joan*

*and Lila returned to Minnesota. It was to be a short vacation from Minnesota, but she immediately fell in the love with the country. When she met Cliff Fuglestad who had an airplane, the thought of ever going back to Minnesota vanished. After marriage in 1954, they lived the life of high adventure, traveling around Alaska with the plane. Once children began arriving, the plane went, but the adventure continued. After construction of the family cabin in Halibut Cove in 1972, she spent all of the following summers from 1973 through 2019 enjoying the beauty and bounty of Kachemak Bay.*

*Not only did Joan raise 6 children, but she welcomed the neighborhood kids, treating them as her own. With great love and discipline Joan made sure her children were able to participate in baseball, skiing, ski patrol, hockey, and figure skating. She empathized the importance of discipline to education. You could find Joan enjoying hockey with the boys or figure skating with the girls. Joan loved to watch baseball and hockey, often rooting for Minnesota. Her love of hockey continued while watching her grandchildren play. Joan also watched her granddaughters compete in figure skating.”*
